NEW LED LIGHTS FOR LOVELY LANE: All of our florescent lights have been replaced with new energy-efficient LED tube lights. The savings in utilities should be very significant!

HOW DOES IT LOOK? We have new 3600K LED bulbs in the Narthex and 5000K LED bulbs in the Kitchen and Fellowship Hall. Please let our staff know how you like the look of these rooms with different light colors.

BLUE ZONE SAYS . . . Eat a food rich in lycopene, such as tomatoes (including tomato sauce or paste!), red peppers, watermelon, guavas, grapefruit, asparagus, red cabbage, or dried basil or oregano. Lycopene is an antioxidant, so it has a protective effect on our body's cells. Studies suggest that it is effective in warding off heart disease and fortifying bone health. Lycopene also shows promise as a way to prevent prostate cancer.
